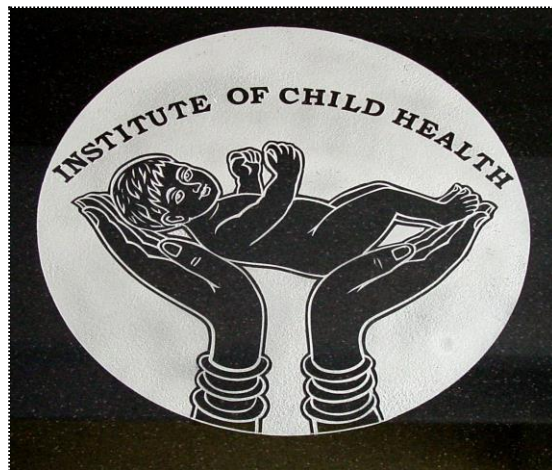

FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME IN PAEDIATRIC INTENSIVE CARE

GOALS OF TRAINING: The general objective of these fellowships is sub-specialty training in cognitive, practical and technical aspects of pediatric intensive care

OBJECTIVES

To provide the Fellow with

Knowledge –

- An individually tailored training programme appropriate to each Fellow's experience and goals
- A sound theoretical knowledge base in normal physiology and pathophysiology of critical illness in children.
- Up to date knowledge of treatment and technologies used in pediatric Intensive care

Skills and Attitudes -

- Clinical experience in the resuscitation, assessment and treatment of critically ill children
- Clinical experience in paediatric transport medicine.
- The opportunity to perform clinical research relevant to the practice of Paediatric Intensive Care
- Assessment, admission and initial management of medical emergency conditions in children.

Communication abilities –

To enhance confidence in fellows by means of case presentations and patient counseling thus contributing to a wholesome education of the resident.

COURSE CONTENTS (SYLLABUS)

Essential Knowledge

- Medical management of congenital heart diseases.
- Medical management of heart failure and severe dysrhythmias.
- Assessment, admission and initial management of critically ill children.
- Management of children with nephrological emergencies such as Acute renal failure and hypertensive emergencies
- Management of children with neurological emergencies such as seizure disorders, neuroinfection, stroke in young, Intracranial bleeds, Herniation syndromes etc.
- Knowledge of ventilator management for respiratory distress and respiratory failure.
- Endocrinological emergencies such as Diabetic Ketoacidosis, Addison's disease, etc
- Post-operative management of neurosurgical, orthopaedic, ENT, general surgical patients, Central role in the RCH Trauma Team, responding to high-level trauma calls in the Emergency Department.
- Providing advice, assessment and practical help (vascular access, procedures) to other clinical services and areas within IGICH.
- Responding to emergency calls for assistance including cardio respiratory arrest as part of the Medical Emergency Team.

Essential Investigation and Diagnostic Procedures

- Management of beds having facilities of centralized oxygen and suction,
- 24 hour monitoring through a centralized monitoring system.
- Management of equipment available in the ICU such as ventilators, defibrillator, centralized monitoring with pulse oximeters and Non-Invasive and Central Venous line monitoring.
- Procedures including peritoneal dialysis, Intercostal Tube drainage, abdominal tap, Central Venous lines and other Cardiocerebro-pulmonary resuscitative measures.
- Assessment of ECHO cardiography, radiology and other diagnostic modalities available.

GRADING OF FELLOWS

Fellow would be assessed regularly as part of the structured training schedule for the fellowship in a graded manner by various consultants and professors on a monthly basis.

TEACHING / LEARNING ACTIVITIES

- A core teaching programme runs every day for 2 hours catering to all the post graduate students of the Hospital under the guidance of experienced staff.
- A mortality meet is conducted to analyse the management and pitfalls within the ICU to help the post graduates and doctors self assess themselves and thus learn.
- Trainees are given protected time to spend in other departments such as Pediatric Cardiology, Gastroenterology, Nephrology, Genetics, Neurodevelopment Clinics, Pediatric Anesthesia, Pediatric Surgery and other such specialities.
- Exclusive hands-on training is provided at the institute to all residents by experienced staff.

DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES

- 1) Journal review meetings- every alternate week
- 2) Seminars –Monthly
- 3) Clinico pathological Conferences – every 3 months
- 4) Inter departmental meeting - monthly
- 5) Clinical rounds – daily
- 6) Participation in conferences and presentation of papers – every 3 months

ROTATION AND POSTING IN OTHER DEPARTMENTS

- 1) Basic medical sciences – 1 Months
- 2) Applied subjects – 15 days
- 3) Allied subjects – 15 days

Research Projects

All registrars and post graduates are encouraged (and expected) to undertake a research or audit project during their fellowship at IGICH. The can be a retrospective review, or a prospective study, or a case series. All projects will be supervised by PICU consultants. We also encourage trainees to consider a formal research period, which a view to a higher degree.

MONITORING OF TEACHING - Log book/Diary will be maintained supervised by the PICU consultants.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

THEORY EXAMINATION – includes 2 theory papers 100 marks each.

- Two long essays(20 marks each)
- Remaining six short essays (10 marks each)

PRACTICAL EXAMINATION – 2 Cases – 75 marks each

VIVA VOCE – 50 marks

Total – 400 marks

• **Duration of Course:**

18 Months (full time work as per RGUHS guidelines and not permitted to work elsewhere)

Eligibility:

- i) MD (Pediatrics), DNB or its Equivalent/DCH with Three Years Clinical Experience.

Selection:

- 1) Candidates will be selected from 4 member panel by interview
(Approved by RGUHS)
- 2) If necessary entrance test will be conducted.

Fees & Stipend:

Fees for the course	:As per IGICH norms
Monthly stipend	:Rs.60000/- Per Month

*In the event of the candidate leaving the course by discountenance or otherwise and thus failing to complete course;

1. The fee paid by candidate will not be refunded.
2. The stipend drawn by the candidate from the Institute during the period of the Fellowship programme to be paid to Institute.

Preference will be given to candidates having three years experience after post graduation in the concerned specialty.
